

COVID-19

Stop! Have you:

- **Returned from international travel (including United States, excluding Maine) after March 8th?**
- **Experienced any symptoms since your international travel?**

If you answered YES to either question, you must avoid all schools, early learning centres and district offices for a period of 14 days. Travelers and family members should self monitor, and if any symptoms occur in a child or family member, immediately contact 811 for further direction.

International travelers who have returned to New Brunswick after March 8th may use current school drop-off zones to drop off/pick up children, but are to avoid all schools, early learning centres and district offices for 14 days.

These directives from the Department of Education and Early Childhood Development have been put in place as precautionary measures, to help protect against the COVID-19 novel Coronavirus.
