Dear Parents/Guardians of Janeville Elementary School:

On May 25, 2015, the Anglophone North School District Education Council voted in favor of engaging in a sustainability study of Janeville Elementary School, under the process of Provincial Policy 409: Multi-Year Infrastructure Planning. This study will explore the sustainability of keeping Janeville Elementary School open. As the student enrolment at Janeville Elementary School is less than 100, a sustainability study is required under Policy 409, which was revised in March 2015 to include a trigger for student enrolment and percentage occupancy. The sustainability study will consist of three public meetings which will be held in the fall. The first meeting will be a district presentation of the facts about the school as we know them. The second meeting will be the community's opportunity to respond, and the final meeting will be a District Education Council meeting where a recommendation to the Minister will be made to either remain status quo or close the school and relocate students. The dates for meetings will be sent out before the end of the 2014-2015 school year.
