Dear Parents/Guardians of Tide Head School:

On November 2, 2018, the Anglophone North District Education Council voted in favor of engaging in a sustainability study of Tide Head School, under the process of Provincial Policy 409: *Multi-Year School Infrastructure Planning*. This study will explore the sustainability of keeping Tide Head School open. As the number of students attending Tide Head School is less than 100, a sustainability study is required under Policy 409, which was revised in March 2015 to include a trigger for student enrolment. **Step 1** - The sustainability study will begin with an outline of the process and facts about Tide Head School as guided by Policy 409. Parents and community members are invited to attend the first public meeting in the consultation process on this sustainability process. The details of the **first public meeting** are as follows:
