DEFINITION

This is entry level professional social work involving the provision of services/interventions to individuals, families and groups to improve social functioning. The work involves assessment and preparation of case analysis; identification of social needs and recommending appropriate action in Student Services in a School District and/or on special education teams. Employees are responsible for preparing case analysis and reports, acting as a resource to educators and are establishing/maintaining effective working relationships with pupils, parents, teaching staff, groups, other government departments, community agencies and the general public. As the variety and difficulty of assignments increases, more latitude in independent judgment and decision making is permitted as the employee acquires knowledge and skill in the assigned areas of activities. Related tasks may be assigned as may become necessary.

DESIRABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE

Graduation from university with a Bachelor in Social Work;

Or

Graduation from university at the bachelor level in a related discipline as recognized by the New Brunswick Association of Social Workers plus related experience.

NECESSARY SPECIAL REQUIREMENT

Registration with the New Brunswick Association of Social Workers.
